2023 NOMINATION FORM & GUIDELINES

Nominate an outstanding woman in our community who has made a lasting difference in the lives of women and girls in the Bow Valley and beyond.

The nominee has through her own initiative, ability and effort demonstrated exemplary achievement in her professional or personal life. She is a role model, a leader, and an inspiration to others. She directs her energies to the well-being of people in her life and her community.

She responds to individual and societal needs with dedication, compassion and courage. She is helping to build a strong community by being an advocate and a change-maker.

She has made substantial contributions to the social fabric of communities here and beyond in unique ways. The contributions she makes provide significant and lasting benefit to the lives of women and girls.

Whether trailblazer in her field or young woman on the rise, she is a pathfinder, bringing forth the key issues facing women and girls today. Through her commitment to social change, she will leave a lasting legacy for future generations.

Nominator Qualifications

- The nominator can be any individual who is interested in nominating an eligible nominee
- The nominator must fully complete the Nomination Form and submit it, along with the support material by 11:59 pm on March 20, 2023
- Current members of the Bow Valley Women of Distinction Awards selection committee are not eliaible to submit nominations
- Multiple nominations from the same nominator are allowed

Nominee Eligibility

Nominees must:

- Be a role model, pioneer or outstanding achiever residing in the Bow Valley including the communities of Banff, Canmore, Lake Louise, Exshaw, Kananaskis and Mini Thni
- Age restrictions: Young Women's Leadership Nominees must be 16 years+. Community Champion
 & Innovation Nominees must be 18 years+
- Support the mission and values of YWCA Banff
- Consent to nomination
- Be available to, or have a representative, attend the awards presentation in May 2022 (Date TBC)

In addition:

- We welcome and encourage inclusive and diverse nominations with respect to nominees' age, nationality, residency status in Canada, and career path
- Previous nominees may be re-nominated



- Previous award recipients; current YWCA Banff employees and Board members; and current Bow Valley Women of Distinction selection committee members are ineligible to be nominated
- Post-humous nominations cannot be accepted

Selection Process

The selection committee is comprised of YWCA Board members and employees, Women of Distinction alumnae and community members. The committee will review all submissions against nomination criteria and guidelines. The committee may contact nominators to confirm information or ask follow-up questions.

Three award recipients will be selected and announced in late April to early May 2023.

Important! If selected as a YWCA Woman of Distinction, the recipient MUST agree to be part of all media promotions, including local media, promotional videos and be acknowledged on the YWCA Banff website. Recipients will also be asked to deliver a short acceptance speech at the 2023 Women of Distinction Awards ceremony on May 11, 2023.

Nomination Categories

Community Champion

This award honors a woman who has initiated meaningful change within the local community, dedicating her own time and resources to champion her cause. She is a visionary trailblazer, a source of strength for her community, and has improved and enriched the lives of others. She has made a significant and sustained difference in the Bow Valley, and is an influential leader through paid work and/or volunteerism in the private, public, or not-for-profit sector.

Innovation

This award honors a woman who boldly embraces new, original ideas and pursues creative ways of making a difference in the business or non-profit sector, or through volunteerism. She is a leader who challenges and motivates others to think outside of the box and explore cutting-edge solutions to improving their surroundings, facilitating change, and creating opportunities whenever possible. She may be a founder, owner, leader or other innovator, creating and implementing innovative programs, practices, partnerships, policies or activities that influence social good and positive change for our community.

Young Women's Leadership

This award recognizes an emerging leader aged 16 - 30, who is an inspirational role model in their career, achievements, or community building roles. She has made a significant difference in the Bow Valley through her commitment to a cause or pursuit of a personal dream while showing perseverance, innovation and a keen understanding of community issues. She inspires others to follow her example, and sets the pace for others to walk alongside her. She is a leader who will continue to inspire us for years to come.
