After last year's highly successful event, YWCA Banff is excited to host our 2024 VINEart Gala & Auction on Saturday, March 16th at the Fairmont Banff Springs.

YWCA Banff has been operating in the Bow Valley since 1913. We care about and are deeply embedded in this community. As local needs shift, we adapt to achieve our mission of shaping a safe and inclusive Bow Valley that empowers women and their community for a better future.

Over the past few years, the need for YWCA Banff's services skyrocketed. From 2020 to 2023, our crisis calls increased by 127%. Last fiscal year alone, 269 callers identified sexual violence, domestic violence, or both as their primary presenting concern, and an additional 279 people contacted YWCA Banff while in a housing-related crisis.

Thanks to the support of community members, businesses, and funders, last fiscal year we provided over 1,400 safe bed nights to folks in the Bow Valley experiencing violence, housing insecurity, or both. In addition to our important work in crisis intervention, YWCA Banff strongly believes in taking a preventative approach to shift social norms and address issues before they arise. Last year we delivered violence prevention and healthy relationship education programs to 1,370 participants. From healthy relationship sessions in schools to workplace and community upstander trainings, these programs promote a violence-free Bow Valley at its roots. Our work is only possible when our community comes together.

The esteemed VINEart Gala & Auction brings together 200 guests from Banff, Canmore, Calgary, and beyond, who are invested in making the Bow Valley a safe and inclusive community for all. Attendees include local business owners, long-term locals, and part-time residents of the Bow Valley. As our biggest fundraiser of the year, VINEart raises critical funds to sustain our core programs while building our capacity to expand and adapt to the needs of people in the Bow Valley. Funds raised will support YWCA Banff's residential programs including emergency shelter, transitional housing, affordable housing, and counselling services. A portion of funds will support our Higher Ground Project, our plan to build a new facility in Canmore to increase our capacity to deliver services across the Bow Valley. We were excited to attend the Palliser Land Transfer announcement in April 2023 and are eager to learn more about the Town of Canmore's Palliser Trail Area Structure Plan and its potential to bring more affordable housing and support services to our community. YWCA Banff has worked closely with the Town of Canmore to realize our Higher Ground Project over the years, and we are hopeful to be included in this much-needed community initiative.

We are all part of the fabric of this community. When a former client sends a handwritten thank you card, when someone who is unhoused finds a long-term place to live in the community, when a young person stands up for someone who is being bullied, or when a survivor of violence can begin to heal, the impact reverberates throughout the Bow Valley.

Our organization thrives thanks to the generosity of our supporters and partners. Whether you are a longstanding partner, or if you haven't had the opportunity to partner with us yet, we invite you to join us as we continue to work towards our vision of a thriving, equitable society.


