- Make reservations over the phone, in person and through online booking tools.
- Responsible for cash float throughout your shift and ensuring it balances correctly at the end
 of shift
- Listen to guest complaints and attempt to resolve issues in a timely manner
- Promote a safe working environment
- Coordinating after-hours support with partner agencies in the community.
- Special projects such as data collection, reporting, and contract preparation.
