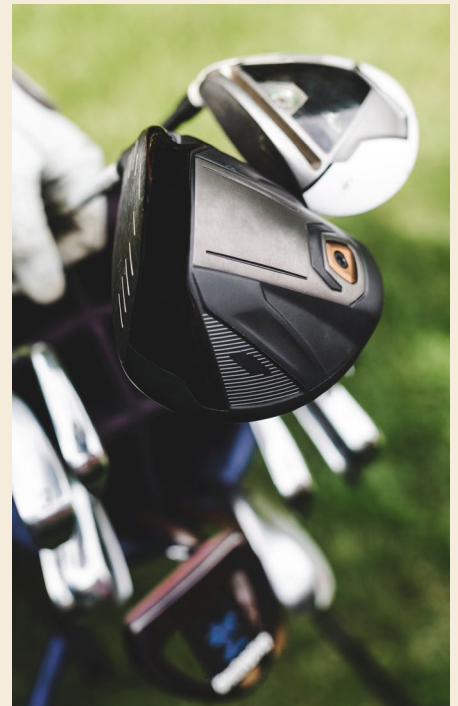

This year's Charity Classic takes place on **Sunday July 28th at Stewart Creek Golf & Country Club.**

The event brings together approximately 100 avid golfers from Canmore, Banff, our regional markets and beyond to raise money for our Higher Ground Project.

Leading up to this wonderful day on the links, Stewart Creek Golf & Country Club's culinary team will host a **5-course dinner with wine pairings on Saturday, July 27th** as part of the fundraiser.

Proceeds will benefit YWCA Banff's Higher Ground Project, our plan to expand our services in the Bow Valley by bringing a new, purpose-built facility to Canmore. Higher Ground will leverage the unique expertise of YWCA Banff and other local agencies to provide a range of services that support people in our community, including women and families, to build their own thriving futures, free from violence.

Over the past three years, YWCA Banff's crisis calls increased by 127%. With the generous support of donors and funders, last fiscal year we served 1,350 community

members and provided 1,431 safe nights to clients accessing emergency sheltering programs. Our team responded to 671 crisis calls, of which 269 callers identified domestic violence, sexual violence, or both as the primary concern. The Higher Ground Project will expand YWCA Banff's capacity to deliver critical services across the Bow Valley including services for those experiencing domestic and sexual violence or housing insecurity.

We are all part of the fabric of this community. When a former client sends a handwritten thank you card, when someone who is unhoused finds a long-term place to live in the community, when a young person stands up for someone who is being bullied, or when a survivor of violence can begin to heal, the impact reverberates throughout the Bow Valley.

We hope you will join us on either day or perhaps both and support this important community initiative.

The Venue

Designed by renowned golf architect Gary Browning, the 18 holes at Stewart Creek has been sculpted into the magnificent Rocky Mountain landscape. Layered fairways and subtly sloped greens, with landing areas defined by pristine forest, mountain streams, lakes and rocky outcrops; while all around breathtaking vistas, brilliant blue

skies, and air tinged the scent of fresh pine complete the picture postcard setting. Here, golf is more than simple sport, it is a celebration of the senses.

The Restaurant at Stewart Creek offers a beautiful rustic setting for any mountain dining experience. Whether it be a pre or post golf

meal, family gathering, business lunch or relaxing end to an active Canmore day, the restaurant has an extensive menu and drink list that both golfers and non-golfers alike are welcome to enjoy. With a deck overlooking the golf course and a fireplace inside there is a table for any weather condition.
